Planning Concerns

City of Norwich Local Plan

A big thank you to all those who wrote to City Hall about this, especially with regard to the demarcation of Eaton Vale and the Bartram Mowers and the Eaton Vale sites. Our voice was certainly heard and the Planning Department is currently considering whether to make some amendments in order to increase the protection to these sites, prior to the Public Enquiry which will finally settle the issue. The enquiry will not be for at least 6 months, and if necessary the Society will give evidence.

AGR Site, Cringleford

Again, thanks to all who wrote. The enquiry was duly held, and the refusal of planning consent for the portacabins was upheld, as was the enforcement notice for their removal. A good result.

Eaton Golf Course

Despite rumours, there has so far been no planning application for change of use for any part of the golf course. Unofficially, we know

the owners are interested in developing some of the land but there may be problems of access from Eaton Rise caused by the old chalk workings.

UEA Building

The present building work on various parts of the campus is unsightly and restricts public access, but is only what was expected when planning consent was given. We have written again to the university pressing for all due care to be taken during the construction work and for speedy restoration of the landscape and public access after completion. We have received some reassurances.
